

## Mandurah Performing Arts Centre (MPAC)

This distinctive centre, built on Mandjar Bay, was a joint initiative between the City of Mandurah and the W.A. State Government and was opened in June 1997.

The major role of the centre is to bring a diverse programme of arts and culture to the community of Mandurah and the wider Peel Region and to become a regional centre of excellence in the arts. Facilities within the centre include the Boardwalk Theatre, which seats 800, the Fishtrap Theatre, which seats 144, an Art Gallery, a Dance Studio, meeting rooms and a foyer with an incredible view of the Bay.
